UNCLAIMED PROPERTY PROGRAM

What is unclaimed property?

Any financial asset that has **NOT** had any owner-generated activity for an extended period of time. Unclaimed property commonly includes:

- Contents of safe deposit boxes
- Deposits held by utility companies
- Dormant savings and checking accounts
- Insurance and medical refunds
- Shares of stock
- Uncashed travelers checks, money orders, dividend checks, payroll checks

Do you have unclaimed property?

Follow these steps to search for unclaimed property:

- ◆ **STEP 1:** Go to the website unclaimedproperty.ehawaii.gov.
- ◆ **STEP 2:** Enter your information into the fields provided.
- ◆ **STEP 3:** Click "BEGIN SEARCH."

Follow website instructions to complete a claim.

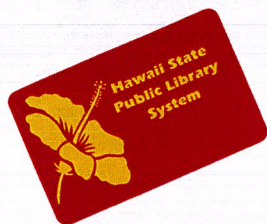
